

Washington USAG Meet Entry Receipt Verification

Faxed entry forms are not acceptable as the means of entry, however, this form may be used to notify the Meet Director of your intention to enter and will offer verification that the "official" entry and payment was received by the Meet Director and when it was received.

Coaches - Fill in the information and fax to the Meet Director along with a copy of your roster sheets. You may want to call the Meet Director 3-4 days in advance of the deadline if you have not received this verification fax. This will give you time to duplicate the entry before any late fees would be applied.

Meet Director - When we receive this fax we are on notice that the entry from this club is forthcoming. When it does arrive, fill in the information and fax it back to the coach. If we receive this form but the official entry and payment DOES NOT arrive by the deadline, we must contact the club by phone or fax to allow time to track the entry and/or duplicate the process in time to enter, late fees may apply.
